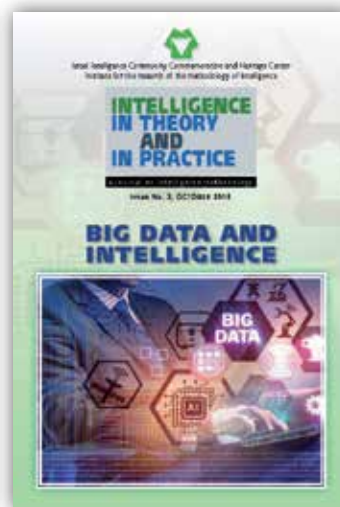
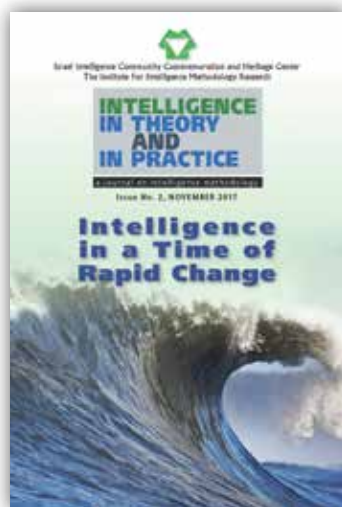
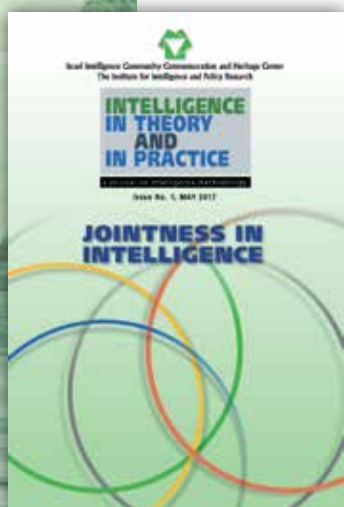
# The Institute for the Research of the Methodology of Intelligence (IRMI)
